DID YOU KNOW...

CHICKENS

Roosters do not lay eggs

Eggs take 3 weeks to hatch into a baby chick

Eggs will not hatch unless kept warm by mother hen or incubator

Eggs will never hatch into chicks unless there is a Rooster around

GOATS

Daddy goats are called "Bucks"

Boy goats who will never be daddies are called "Whethers"

Mommy goats are called "Does"

Mommy goats are pregnant for 5 months

Boys goats are sometimes referred to as "Billy Goats"

Girl goats are sometimes referred to as "Nanny Goats"

Baby goats can walk on their own minutes after being born

Baby goats can jump and climb within days after being born

Goat "hair" is called Fleece

SHEEP

Mommy sheep are called "Ewes"

Daddy sheep are called "Rams"

Baby sheep are called "Lambs"

Sheep are shorn twice a year

Sheep "hair" is called wool
